Score is in C. Piccolo, celesta and xylophone sound one Sve higher than written. Glockenspiel sounds two Sves higher and double basses one octave lower.

Tied notes should be repeated only as often as necessary to sustain volume, and breathing and bow changes should be staggered. Fresh attacks should be avoided insofar as possible, especially in the piano (and harp) when tied clusters need to be repeated.

The fourth beat in measure 9 may be held somewhat longer than its full value to accomodate the solo.

Continue preceding material.

Ord. indicates return to standard tone after passages played non vibrate (or sul ponticello).

Duration: 102 minutes.

## Performance notes:

In measures 1, 64, 135, and 150, either a large suspended cymbal or a Tam-tam may be used. The pitch should be low but not extremely low.

Beginning in measure 99, the tempo may be between  $\dot{\epsilon} = 76\text{-}100$
