Performance Notes:

- 1. A small triangle is played once at the end of Long, Too Long,

 O Land by a member of the chorus. Otherwise, all percussion
 is played by the percussionist.
- 2. The bass range extends down to be, although the lowest two notes are generally treated as optional and are enclosed in parentheses. If basses are available who can sing them, however, they should do so.
- 3. Percussion instrumentation: tam tam, suspended cymbal, snare drum, bass drum, xylophone, glockenspiel, triangle, tambourine, timpani

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
